

A Holy Land Trip for Episcopalians and families

Space is limited to fifty people only. Booking has begun, soon to close.

- ❖ The Episcopal Church of St. Michael and All Angels, Columbia, SC is hosting a study tour to the Holy Land. This unique opportunity will include Christmas in Bethlehem and services of The Holy Eucharist on the Mount of Beatitudes, in Jericho, and at the Episcopal Cathedral in Jerusalem. We will sail on the Sea of Galilee as we trace the life of Jesus in places like Capernaum, Nazareth, the Mount of Olives and the Via Dolorosa. Since many people on the trip are over 70, the pace is easy-walking and by private bus.
- ❖ This is a study tour with instruction by Dr. Monte Luker from Columbia, SC, a professor of Hebrew Scriptures and the Bible who has taught here and in the Holy Land for over 30 years.
- ❖ Dec. 20, 2010-Jan.2, 2011 are the dates for our trip, leaving from and arriving back to the Columbia airport: one price includes all airfare, all housing, all breakfasts and dinners, transportation, instruction, security, entrance to sites, tips, taxes. Only lunches and souvenirs are separate costs. Reservations may be made online or by mail or by phone (see **brochure**).
